Dear Parents/Carers,

As promised here is an update regarding the situation with the St. Margaret's school building.

Unfortunately, a significant part of our building still cannot be accessed. We are in the process of making longer term alternative arrangements for your child's education for after half term but, for Friday 9<sup>th</sup> February, the following arrangements will stand:

- Nursery – as usual
- Reception – as usual
- Year 1 – will continue to be taught in the Year 3 Stream room and the library, same as today
- Year 2 – will use the staffroom and the hall – the classes will swap venues at lunchtime
- Year 3 – as usual
- Year 4 – as usual
- Year 5 – Year 5 stream room and St. Margaret's church. All pupils will register in the Year Five stream class and will swap venues at lunch time.
- Year 6 – Northbury Primary School. All pupils will arrive and will be collected from St. Margaret's as usual. All contact regarding your child will still be made to St. Margaret's.

My heartfelt thanks goes to St Margaret's Church and to Northbury Primary School for helping us at this time along with the staff for their flexibility and professionalism throughout this situation.

We will provide a further update tomorrow, including our provision for after half term, and, once again, I thank you for your understanding.
