

Agreement for Parents/Carers

We acknowledge that we as parents are the primary educators of our children and we have an irreplaceable role to play in supporting our children's learning at school.

1. Make sure my child attends school regular and arrives and is collected on time.
2. Contact the school as soon as possible, by phone or in writing, if my child is absent.
3. Talk to my child about their experiences in school and encourage them to do their best.
4. Support and encourage my child with their homework (in particular by reading regularly with my child and encouraging them to become interested in books).
5. Ensure that my child is properly equipped for school (P.E. kit, reading book bag etc.).
6. Work with the school to try and make sure that my child behaves well.
7. Get in touch if there are any problems at home that may affect my child's work or behaviour.
8. Attend parent's meetings and discussions about my child's progress.
9. Contribute to school funding projects according to my means.
10. In so far as I have time take an interest in activities for the school community, church services, school fetes, P.T.A. events etc.

Agreement for School

The School will

1. Offer a balanced and carefully planned curriculum, which meets the needs of your child
2. Ensure that your child is valued for who s/he is and is helped to make good progress in their spiritual, academic, social and physical development.
3. Challenge your child strive for high standards in all they do by setting realistic, achievable targets for English and Maths for your child and ensure learning is progressive and continuous.
4. Let you know regularly how your child is progressing and provide you with a midyear report and have opportunities to discuss their attainment with the appropriate teacher.
5. Set, mark and monitor homework (including reading) appropriate to your child's needs.
6. Contact you as soon as possible if we are concerned about your child's health, attendance, work or behaviour.
7. Make the school safe, secure, friendly environment for your and your child.
8. Encourage high standards of behaviour, in particular respecting other people and property.
9. Encourage your child to be a confident and responsible individual ready to take their place in society.
10. Keep you well informed about school policies and activities through regular newsletters.
