After researching the current situation regarding the conflict, members of the School Council decided to hold class assemblies: to ensure all the children at St Margaret's are informed about the conflict and to decide on how we can help the Ukrainian refugees, who have been displaced and had their lives negatively impacted. The children of St Margaret's decided it was best to raise money for this cause. After careful deliberation, the School Council decided to donate the funds to the British Red Cross. During parents' evening, some of our School council members collected donations that were generously gifted by the fantastic parents and carers of St Margaret's. We want to thank you for your generosity; from this we were able to raise £411.30 for the Ukrainian refugees! Well done to the School Council members, who have demonstrated the Young Transformers values as well as their school and Christian values so well by caring for those in our international community.

In addition to the above money being raised, we have also raised an additional £300 for Red Nose Day! A huge thank you to you all for digging deep in those pockets to help others.

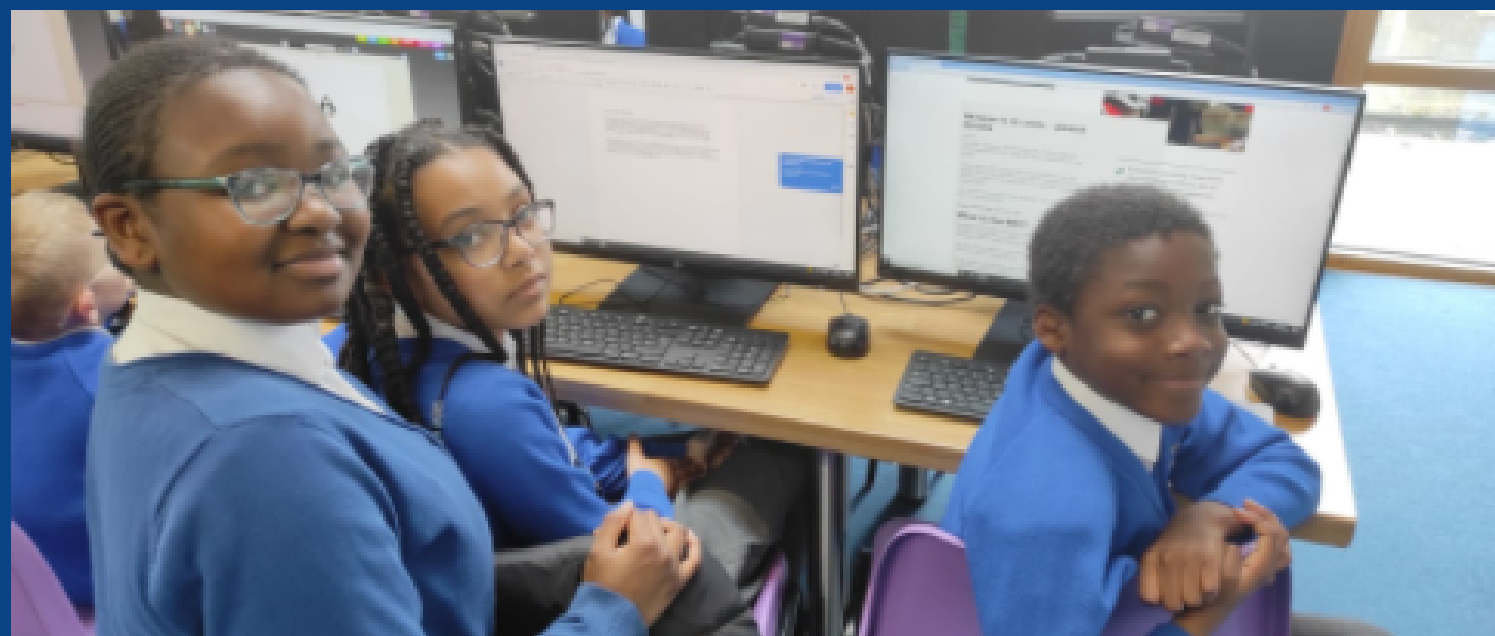
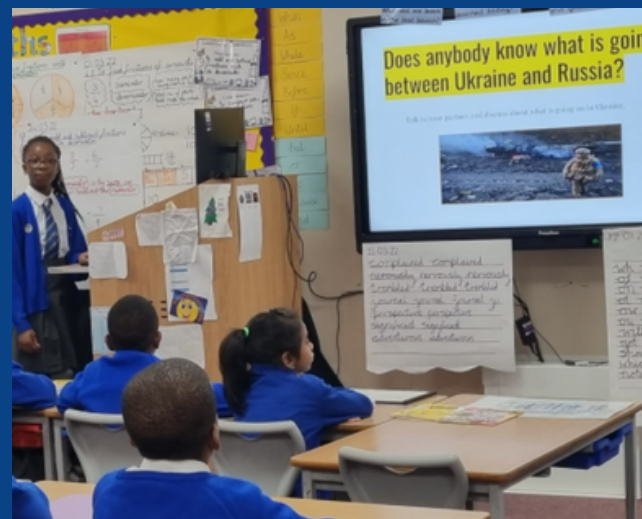
I would like to conclude this newsletter with a biblical quote from Hebrews 13:16
