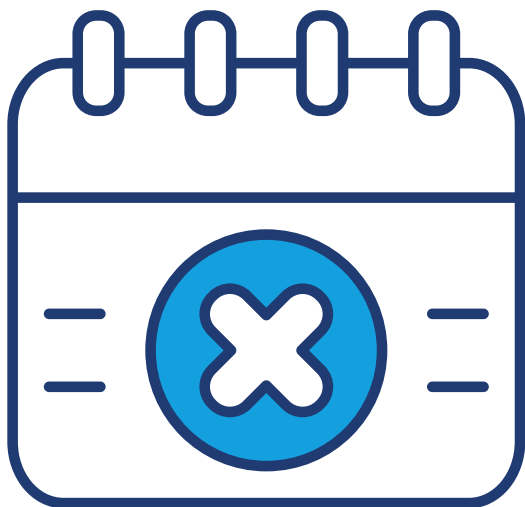

If you are late to collect your child, you will be charged a late fee each time your child is collected late, which will be put on Parent Pay.

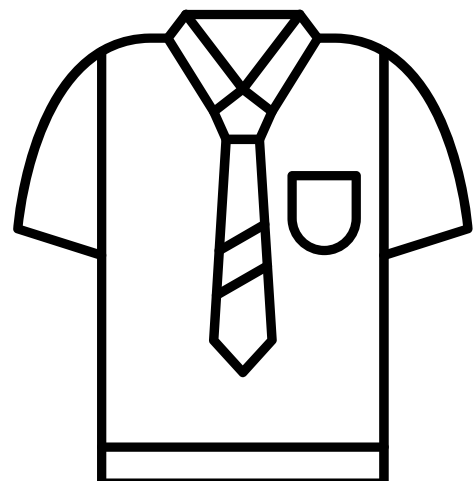


## Absence
